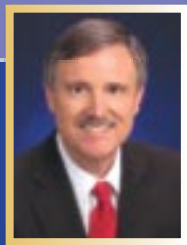


## About the Speaker



Nearly 40 years ago, a 19-year-old sophomore at Harvard authored a student leadership manual. In it he encouraged students to work together and collaborate...to have regard for the system. The results, he assured, would be positive, and they would foster lasting change. Within the manual, he included his paradoxical commandments, which were destined to change his own life, and the lives of so many others around the world who would come across his wisdom over many decades.

**Kent M. Keith's** career path became one that exemplified servant leadership as he accepted positions and roles that welcomed his positive impact and desire to make a difference. He practiced law for two years and served seven years in the State of Hawaii Department of Planning and Economic Development, ultimately serving in the Governor's cabinet. Dr. Keith also led the construction and infrastructure development of a technology park, served as president of Chaminade University in Honolulu (a Marian University), and became Sr. V.P. for Development and Communications for the YMCA of Honolulu.

All the while, he was unaware of how his paradoxical commandments were circling the globe. Today, Dr. Keith shares with us what prompted the 2002 re-publishing of his book, *Anyway: The Paradoxical Commandments*, and how the insights of a college student in 1968 still help us in 2006 to find personal meaning as we face adversity and challenge day after day.
